
IB DOWNLOADER PRIVACY NOTICE

BACKGROUND:

Maia EDA Ltd. understands that your privacy is important to you and that you care about how your personal data is used. We respect and value the privacy of all of our users and will only collect and use personal data in ways that are described here, and in a way that is consistent with our obligations and your rights under the law.

This Privacy Notice applies specifically to the use of the 'IB Downloader' Browser Extension, which may be downloaded from the Chrome Web Store or AMO (addons.mozilla.org).

1. Information About Us

Maia EDA is a Limited Company registered in England and Wales under company number 12872660. Our registered address is Milfield, Quebec Road, Dereham, Norfolk NR19 2DR.

2. What Does This Notice Cover?

This Privacy Notice explains how we use your personal data: how it is collected, how it is held, and how it is processed. It also explains your rights under the law relating to your personal data.

3. What Is Personal Data?

Personal data is defined by the UK GDPR and the Data Protection Act 2018 (collectively, "the Data Protection Legislation") as 'any information relating to an identifiable person who can be directly or indirectly identified in particular by reference to an identifier'.

Personal data is, in simpler terms, any information about you that enables you to be identified. Personal data covers obvious information such as your name and contact details, but it also covers less obvious information such as identification numbers, electronic location data, and other online identifiers.

The personal data that we use is set out in Part 5, below.

4. What Are My Rights?

Under the Data Protection Legislation, you have the following rights, which we will always work to uphold:

- a) The right to be informed about our collection and use of your personal data. This Privacy Notice should tell you everything you need to know, but you can always contact us to find out more or to ask any questions using the details in Part 11.
- b) The right to access the personal data we hold about you. Part 10 will tell you how to do this.
- c) The right to have your personal data rectified if any of your personal data held by us is inaccurate or incomplete. Please contact us using the details in Part 11 to find out more.
- d) The right to be forgotten, i.e. the right to ask us to delete or otherwise dispose of any of your personal data that we hold. Please contact us using the details in Part 11 to find out more.

- e) The right to restrict (i.e. prevent) the processing of your personal data.
- f) The right to object to us using your personal data for a particular purpose or purposes.
- g) The right to withdraw consent. This means that, if we are relying on your consent as the legal basis for using your personal data, you are free to withdraw that consent at any time.
- h) The right to data portability. This means that, if you have provided personal data to us directly, we are using it with your consent or for the performance of a contract, and that data is processed using automated means, you can ask us for a copy of that personal data to re-use with another service or business in many cases.
- i) Rights relating to automated decision-making and profiling.

5. What Personal Data Do You Collect and How?

We collect the personal and non-personal data set out in the table below, using the methods also set out in the table. This data is processed and held solely within the Browser Extension itself, and is not transmitted to or held by any other party, including ourselves (Maia EDA Ltd). The 'Session Identifier' and member data are also stored locally on your own device using the 'chrome.storage' API. This data may be deleted by uninstalling the Browser Extension.

Any data transmitted between the Browser Extension and your SwimAdmin club site is transmitted securely, using Transport Layer Security (TLS).

Your username for your SwimAdmin club site	Entered into a Login form
Your password for your SwimAdmin club site	Entered into a Login form
A 'Session Identifier' for your SwimAdmin club site. This is encrypted data which allows your SwimAdmin club site to determine whether or not you are currently logged in	This is derived by, and returned from, your SwimAdmin club site when it has confirmed the validity of your login credentials
Your member data (a list of member names together with their Swim England membership numbers)	This is returned from your SwimAdmin club site when it has confirmed the validity of your login credentials
The contents of one or more 'Individual Best' pages at swimmingresults.org	Automatically scraped

6. How Do You Use My Personal Data?

Under the Data Protection Legislation, we must always have a lawful basis for using personal data. The following table describes how we use your personal data, and our lawful bases for doing so:

What We Do	What Data We Use	Our Lawful Basis
Log into your SwimAdmin club site	Your login credentials	This step is required to retrieve your member data
Scrape your member 'Individual Best' data from swimmingresults.org, and record it as a text file on your own device	The member data returned from your SwimAdmin club site	To provide the advertised functionality of the Browser Extension

Your personal and non-personal data is not used for any other purpose.

7. How Long Will You Keep My Personal Data?

We do not record or hold any of your data, personal or otherwise.

8. How and Where Do You Store or Transfer My Personal Data?

We do not store or transfer your data, personal or otherwise.

9. Do You Share My Personal Data?

We will not share any of your data, personal or otherwise, with any third parties for any purposes.

10. How Can I Access My Personal Data?

We do not record or hold any of your data, personal or otherwise.
